In 1995 a group of friends gathered at the Cedars Lanes in Cedarburg to watch the Green Bay Packers play the Cleveland Browns. About fifty people attended the first year. Each year a few more people joined us at this annual event.

In 1999 Blaine Bergmann lost his sister to cancer. The event decided to raise money for Blaine's niece, a Special Olympian. Ozaukee County Special Olympics was the recipient of \$300 that year.

In 2007 over 500 people attended the event with a total of \$28,000 donated to charity.
